LEARNING ACTIVITIES

PRACTICAL TRAINING AND ASSESSMENT

Perform 2 minutes of uninterrupted CPR on an adult manikin.

Simulated First Aid Scenario – Perform CPR on an adult manikin (incl. the use of an AED and placing a casualty into the recovery position).

Perform CPR on an infant.

Manage a casualty with anaphylaxis.

Manage a casualty with asthma.

Manage a choking casualty.

Manage a casualty with a nosebleed.

Manage a casualty with a fracture and dislocation.

Manage a casualty with a sprain and strain.

Manage a casualty with envenomation (snake/ funnel-web spider bite).

Manage a casualty with non-life-threatening bleeding and shock, requiring minor wound cleaning.

Complete a first aid incident report form based on the simulated First Aid Scenario.

CERTIFICATE RENEWAL REQUIREMENTS

The Code of Practice recommends that refresher training in CPR should be carried out every twelve (12) months and Provide First Aid qualifications should be renewed every three (3) years.

COURSE FEES AND PAYMENTS

To undertake the First Aid Course the following fees are required to be paid prior to the course commencement date.

Full fee-paying student – \$140
